



# APPLICATION TO TRANSFER A WATER ACCESS ENTITLEMENT

This application for the transfer of a Water Access Entitlement (WAE) is made under section 26 of the *Water Resources Act 2007*.

A Water Access Entitlement (WAE) provides a right (specified as a share) to surface water or groundwater within a specified water management area. A WAE does not permit the use of water for a particular purpose or from a particular location. Those activities are permitted by a Licence to Take Water. You will need to apply for a Licence to Take Water before you can take any water.

#### NOTE:

A Water Access Entitlement can only be transferred when it has been paid in full. To determine if the WAE has been paid for or to make a payment, please contact Water Regulation on 13 22 81 or email <a href="mailto:environment.protection@act.gov.au">environment.protection@act.gov.au</a>

A Surviving Allocation (issued under the repealed *Water Resources Act 1998*) cannot be transferred. If this transfer involves a Surviving Allocation, the current owner needs to request, in writing, to surrender the Allocation and have it replaced with a tradeable WAE. Payment for the WAE will be required upon issue.

Conditions may exist on a Water Access Entitlement that restricts it to a particular location or for a specific purpose. Please contact Environment and Dangerous Substances Licensing on 13 22 81 to discuss any aspect of your application or refer to the *Water Resources Act 2007* for further information.

All licences and water access entitlements granted under the *Water Resources Act 2007* are included on the Water Resources Register and hence are public documents.
