## **AUTHORISED INSPECTION STATION RENEWAL DECLARATION**

As the Proprietor/Proprietor's Nominee of Station **S**....., I provide this declaration to verify that all mandatory test equipment used for conducting roadworthy inspections on behalf of the Authorised Examiner Scheme, is in good working order and calibrated in accordance with the equipment manufacturers recommendations or every 6 months if the manufacturer has not stated the intervals required for service and calibration.

I acknowledge that if a station inspection is conducted by Access Canberra auditors on my Authorised Inspection Station and any test equipment is found to not be functioning correctly or a calibration certificate/label is missing or has expired, then Access Canberra may take action by imposing a suspension to the station's authorisation.

***Section 127 of the Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulation 2000, eligibility of premises states that the premises, the equipment proposed to be used on the premises in relation to the inspection and testing of vehicles must comply with prescribed requirements.***

***Section 130 of the Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulation 2000 defines when the road transport authority may refuse an application by a person for approval of premises (which includes renewal of an approval) when the authority believes on reasonable grounds that the premises are not eligible to be approved.***

***Section 135 of the Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulation 2000, states that the road transport authority may take action under section 136 in relation to the approval of premises if the premises was approved because of a false or misleading statement made, or false or misleading information was given, which may result in either a suspension or a cancellation of up to 2 years.***
