





Alex has a current WWVP registration but has recently been **convicted** for drink driving.



Access Canberra receives information regarding the new offence through continuous monitoring of WWVP registrants.



Alex is contacted by Access Canberra with regards to the offence.

After an investigation, Access Canberra proposes an interim condition on their registration.



Alex accepts the interim conditions on their registration and will not be allowed to transport vulnerable people until a final decision is made.

## What can Alex do now?



Alex will be given a new card with the interim conditions.



Access Canberra will tell Alex's employer that the registration is now subject to interim conditions.



Alex must comply with all interim conditions placed on their registration.
