





Alex has applied for a WWVP registration to work with children in an NDIS activity.



Access Canberra identifies that Alex has a Class A disqualifying offence of possessing child pornography.



Alex is issued with an interim bar preventing them from working while their application is pending.



Alex is given a negative notice. The notice prohibits them from gaining a WWVP registration for working with children or in an NDIS activity.

What can Alex do now?



Alex can reapply to work in child related or NDIS activities ONLY if their conviction is quashed.



Access Canberra will notify Alex's employer of the outcome of the WWVP application.



Alex may be able to apply for a WWVP registration to work in other regulated activities.
