- understand that this consent, once signed, remains valid while you are a customer of the Access Canberra unless withdrawn by contacting the RTA or the department directly;
- agree to obtain proof of your entitlement from the department regarding your concession and provide it to the Access Canberra so that your eligibility for any relevant concession, rebate or service can be determined; and
- acknowledge that if you withdraw your consent or do not alternatively provide proof of your entitlement as requested by the Access Canberra that you may be refused or found ineligible for the concession, rebate or service provided. The percentage of concession entitlement is based on the *Road Transport (General) Concession Determination* and may change from time to time.

Access Canberra is authorised to retain a digital copy of your photograph and signature under Part 4 of the *Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Act 1999*. Retained images may be used to assist in addressing identity fraud and disclosed to law enforcement and court agencies, interstate road authorities, or when authorised by law. If you choose not to provide the personal information requested on this form, we may not be able to process your request. Personal information for this application is not normally disclosed to overseas recipients unless required by law.
