   Your employer must also have a master temporary visitor licence issued for the special event before this application will be approved.

- You must complete and submit all relevant parts of the application form and provide all requested documentation before your application will be processed and a decision is made to grant a licence. All supporting documentation must be provided to Access Canberra.

Special Event is an event, approved by the Commissioner, of social, cultural, sporting, political or economic significance to the Australian Capital Territory that takes place for a specific period of time. The circumstances of the event must be such that the resources of the ACT private security industry are not sufficient to service the event, unless the need for specific or specialised skill can be proven. Your employer must have demonstrated the above to be issued a master temporary visitor licence for the event.
