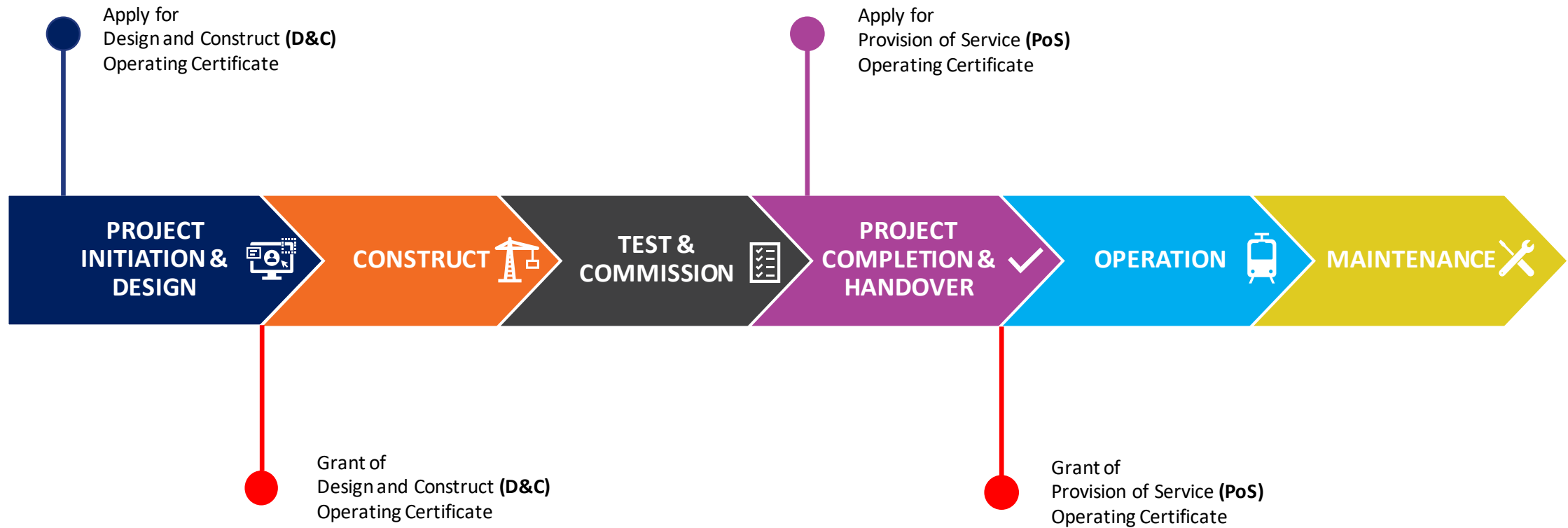


Regulatory Approval Timeline



Regulatory Approval (D&C) Steps



Engagement

- Discuss with Utilities Technical Regulation (UTR) team proposed regulated utility electrical network
- Understand applicable legislation and requirements – UTR Act and Technical Codes



Preparation and Submission

- Submit an Operating Certificate Application (section 43, UTR Act)
- Develop a Design and Construct (D&C) Regulatory Plan and other supporting documents in consultation with UTR



Assessment and Approval

- Assessment of the regulatory submission (consideration at *section 46, UTR Act*)
- Recommendation to the Technical Regulator to grant an Operating Certificate (*section 46(1), UTR Act*)



Invoices

- Fees determination (monthly) and advice (*section 48, UTR Act*)
- Payment of the Fees - Fees Instrument



Construction, Testing and Commissioning

- Demonstrate compliance with the Operating Certificate and D&C Regulatory Plan (*section 49, UTR Act*)
- Supply Independent Electrical Certifier's compliance report
- Provide on-going updates to the Technical Regulator on progress of the regulated utility network
